

Asset Organizer Droplet - By Anthony Collurafici

Asset Organizer is a Droplet to speed up the workflow of creating assests for Android Apps based on the recommend working space that organizes assests by screen density.

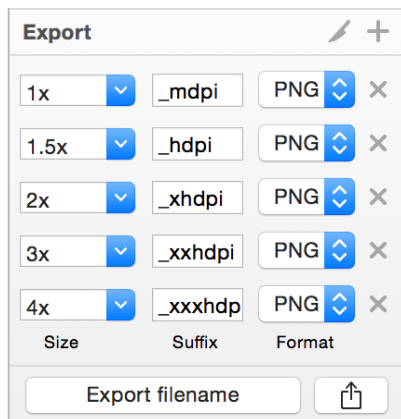
Installation:

Just extract the droplet somewhere suitable.
Hold Command then Drag the Icon to your finder toolbar.

Usage:

1. Export your assets with a suffix of the desired folder name starting with an underscore (ex. filename_mdpi.png).

Sketch users may use the Export panel as follows










Note: This app was originally designed for saving Android assets but you can use any suffix you would like.

2. Open Containing folder in the finder.
3. Click Asset Organizer Icon in the toolbar.

The Organizer will create folders based on the suffixes of the files you exported in the current folder, move the files to their respective folder and remove the suffixes form the filename.

Note: If the folder is already present the Organizer will not create another, but will still move the file.
